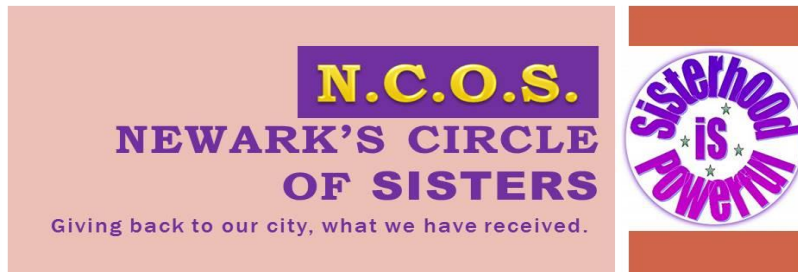


The NEWARK CIRCLE OF SISTERS PRESENTS:

All applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Must be a graduate of/will be a graduate of a Newark high school.
- Must be a Newark resident. (You can attend school outside of the state).
- Planning to enroll in an accredited college or university in Fall 2014.
- Has a history of service to the Newark community.
- Be able to submit two letters of recommendation.
- High School Seniors must have a minimum GPA of 2.75.
- Proof of acceptance to at least one school by the application deadline – **April 1, 2014.** Notification of recipients by **May 31, 2014.**
